### Psalm 139:13-18

For you created my inmost being; you knit me together in my mother's womb. I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; your works are wonderful, I know that full well. My frame was not hidden from you when I was made in the secret place. When I was woven together in the depths of the earth, your eyes saw my unformed body. All the days ordained for me were written in your book before one of them came to be. How precious to me are your thoughts, O God! How vast is the sum of them! Were I to count them, they would outnumber the grains of sand. When I awake, I am still with you.

Job 10:11 **You** clothed **me** with skin and flesh, and **you knit** my bones and sinews together.

Ps 22:9 Yet you brought me safely from my **mother's** womb and led me to trust you when I was a nursing infant.

Psa 131:2 But I have stilled and quieted myself, just as a small child is quiet with its **mother**. Yes, like a small child is my soul within me.

Ephesians 2:10 For we are God's masterpiece. **He has created us anew** in Christ Jesus, so that we can do the things he planned for us long ago.

### We are all a reflection of God's creation

John 4:24 God is spirit, and his worshipers must worship in spirit and in truth

Genesis 1:27 So God created people (NIV - man) in his own image; God patterned them after himself; male and female he created them.

Galatians 3:28 There is neither Jew nor Greek, slave nor free, male nor female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus.

When he speaks of a "mother" or "father", God is referring to a role, not a gender.

### The Holy Spirit

Rom 8:26 "Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered."

His Names are: Paracletos (the One who comes along side), Advocate (like a mother defending her own child), Comforter, Friend, Teacher, Helper, Strengtheners, and Exhorter...these are all things that a mother does.

## God's Love for us is more than mother and father!

**Psalm 27:10** Even if my father and **mother** abandon me, the LORD will hold me close.

**Psalm 71:6** Yes, you have been with me from birth; from my **mother's** womb you have cared for me. No wonder I am always praising you!

**Isaiah 66:13** As a mother comforts her child, so will I comfort you; and you will be comforted over Jerusalem."

## God's Love sustains us, even when our Mother's don't

**Isa 49:15** "Can a woman forget her nursing child, and have no compassion on the son of her womb? Even these may forget, but I will not forget you."

**Psalm 27: 10** Even if my father and mother abandon me, the Lord will hold me close.

## Our Response to one another

**1Th 2:7** As apostles of Christ we certainly had a right to make some demands of you, but we were as gentle among you as a **mother** feeding and caring for her own children.

**1Ti 5:2** Treat the older women as you would your **mother**, and treat the younger women with all purity as your own sisters.
